#### Dear Friends & Neighbors,

At our annual meeting in October, the Board reviewed major projects we would move forward with in 2021 and/or 2022. Due to labor shortages, most of these projects will occur in 2022. We want to give you a quick financial recap to keep everyone in the loop as to how we're spending our funds.

## **2021 Operational Costs – Underspending**

In 2021, the Keys underspent our operating budget and reserved funds for 2022 major projects in three categories: Irrigation Infrastructure Refurb, Storm Water Mitigation, and Tree Health. The total 2021 funds added to our cash reserve due to the underspending was approximately \$35,000, broken into these categories.
