1. CALL TO ORDER – Russ Timmons

4. Network Real Estate - Kevin McKoy

Kevin introduced himself and spoke about the role his company plays in helping the community. Network realty is in charge of all non financial matters such as supervising the termite inspection. The company oversees the landscaping, pond etc. Network is the first line of contact. Feel free to ask any questions at any time.

Bruce Yergler asked about bush trimming. Sam's is in the process of doing that currently.

5. Budget Presentation – Grace Mc Gee

Grace discussed her replacement.

Grace presented a simplified chart of the 2024 budget. (See chart attached). The majority of the budget (52%) goes to landscaping, mulch and irrigation. Grace explained long term maintenance such as painting, termite prevention, sinkholes. Grace explained the reserves. In terms of reserves, Grace explained that Becky Richardson asked about roofs. The community will be surveyed about how to proceed regarding the roofs. Kevin has been tasked with finding a reputable roofer to assess the roofs. Fortified roofs were discussed.

6. Board PRESENTATION

• Architecture – Russ Timmons

Russ discussed architecture and reminded the community on how to proceed if you want to make changes to the outside of the house. Forms are available online and through Kevin.

- Rules & Regulation changes Patio, Rain Barrel Privacy Fences Eve MacCurry Eve discussed the changes which were added to the Rules and Regulations during the past year. This included clarification of awning color allowed which is beige without stripes. The storm doors were also addressed these must be white with clear glass, but can have a break in the middle to accommodate a screen. Patios were also addressed. These must be professionally installed and follow guidelines outlined in the Rules and Regulations. Privacy fences were added. This must be white and be no more than 4' tall and no mare than 4' wide.
 - Landscaping Lollo Erickson

Lollo spoke about haw much he loves the area. Lollo is working with Kevin to keep improving the environment. He spoke highly about the contractors such a Sam's. Special items have been imbedded in the contract. Aggressive approach to trimming has been initiated. The tree service Fitness Tree has been very reliable and inexpensive. We compared the price with other vendors. Rainstorm Solutions dredged the pond in conjunction with the town experts. Irrigations system is working for us because equipment has bee replaced. The system is working well. Some damage is caused by vehicles. Jeff cline and Mailin Irrigation. The lawn was also focused on this year. TruGreen is working on the lawns. one spots still need to be repaired. Insects are controlled and bare spots are coming back. The beautification initiative has been a success.

• Pond - Frank Watkins

Frank reported that we have replaced the riprap and and dredged the pond. There is a new alligator in the pond
